Subject: 2022 North Carolina Malting Barley OVT

Enclosed are instructions and application form for 2021-22 Malting Barley trials. Malting Barley will be tested at 3 locations (Mills River, Salisbury, and Kinston). Entries may be submitted with treatment as long as it is a labeled, commercially available seed treatment and the treatment is identified on the seed tag. Entries are submitted for all locations.

The above locations represent the areas of North Carolina where malting production and needs are the greatest, and where a large proportion of the barley in North Carolina is grown. In addition to standard yield and agronomic data from these plots, samples will be submitted for complete malting quality data on the harvested seed. All data, along with a sample of harvested seed from each location, will subsequently be provided to the major malt houses in North Carolina for inclusion in their testing.

Please adhere to the established deadlines so we may plant the tests on time.

FEES: \$330/entry
